



## Confined Space Rescue

<b>DURATION</b>	8 hours
<b>UNIT</b>	Aligned with some elements of the public safety training package
<b>TRAINING PACKAGE</b>	Not nationally accredited
<b>TARGET AUDIENCE</b>	Persons requiring the knowledge and skills to set up and operate rescue systems for confined spaces
<b>PRE-REQUISITES</b>	Current competency in confined space working
<b>COURSE OUTCOMES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Legislative requirements for confined space rescue</li><li>The role of a stand-by person</li><li>Set up of fall restraint systems</li><li>Set up of lifting frames (tripod)</li><li>Set up and use of basic lifting systems</li><li>Set up and use of basic lowering systems</li></ul>
<b>MAXIMUM PARTICIPANTS</b>	The maximum number of participants is 8
<b>ON-SITE DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS</b>	Participants must attend in approved work wear and PPE and each site must provide the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>A suitable harness for all participants</li><li>Suitable classroom area</li><li>A sound structure permitting a number of rope rescue scenarios including from height and depths</li></ul>
